The All Youth Matter Series is focused on creating an awareness and understanding about the addiction cycle and how individual, families and communities are affected. This training is open to all Youth between the ages of 12-17, each youth must have a chaperone attending with them.

Course Description

This program offers youth training on alcohol and drug awareness and counselling skills. Each topic relates to and builds on skills learned during the previous course. This program will provide youth with an orientation and awareness to experiential training as well as develop a deeper understanding in leading a healthy addictions free lifestyle. Topics include: Communications and Ethics, Addictions, Family Disease, Assessment and Intervention, Treatment, Aftercare, Personal Growth, Youth Suicide, Grief, and Loss. The final day is spent on reflection and developing a community action plan to encourage all youth to begin their healing journey in a safe environment.
