COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This five-day course explores the impact of Crystal Meth on the lives of Indigenous individuals, families, and communities. This course provides participants with the opportunity to enhance their knowledge, skills and awareness required to effectively develop and implement a Preventative Community Action Plan to address the impacts of Crystal Meth Addiction. The training consists of lectures, video presentations, small and large group work and discussions and self-care for service providers. The topics covered in this training session include:

- Discussion on the history of methamphetamine;
- Identify what crystal meth is;
- Dynamics of Crystal Meth use and effects on the body;
- Explore crystal meth use and youth-child endangerment;
- The results of damage caused by crystal meth production homes; and
- Prevention, Awareness, Community Education.
