COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course will provide students with the opportunity to gain knowledge, skills and awareness of Identity and belonging, relating to beadwork/cloth regalia. Students will gain knowledge about historical impacts to Indigenous Peoples and how Indigenous Arts was impacted and resilient. Students will hear oral storytelling relating to the following themes:

- Indigenous Regalia;
- Origins of dance and song;
- Trauma, grief, loss and dislocation;
- Cultural Teachings (i.e. Rites of Passage);
- Cosmology (Origins and development of the Universe);
- Medicine Wheel Concepts;
- Sobriety and wellness; and
- Empowerment.

Outcomes: Participants will complete a traditional beadwork/cloth project (i.e. miniature dolls, ribbon skirt or day dress)
